Are you interested in starting your own business? Pitch your Business is for students that want to see their businesses come to life. The business ideas must be viable and can be easily implemented over the summer or in the near future. Below you will see key components that should be included in your pitch but **remember to be creative!**

The Process and Eligibility Requirements:

- Students must be between the ages of 15 to 21 and currently attending high school or post-secondary.
- If students are 18 and under, a parent or guarantor must sign a consent form allowing the student to participate in the process and for the student to participate in the pitch competition, if selected.
- Must be a resident of the Nipissing or Parry Sound Districts.
- Students must complete a fillable application and return it to Kennedy Horton, Youth and Mentorship Coordinator at khorton@tbcnps.ca or drop it off at The Business Centre Nipissing Parry Sound, located on the 6th Floor of City Hall.
- The Business Centre will review all applications and determine which students are eligible to participate in the pitch competition on **Wednesday, October 23, 2019 at 250 Clark in Powassan.**
- The Business Centre will contact you if you have been selected by **Tuesday, October 8th, 2019.**

Pitch Day Requirements (October 23):

If you are selected to pitch your business in the pitch competition here is a breakdown of what the judges are looking for:

- Viability of Business
 - Clear description of the business.
 - Meets a specific need and/or fills a gap in the community/solves a problem.
 - Target Market is identified.
- Creativity
 - Creative messaging.
 - Brand development (Company Name, logo and tag line).
 - Creative use of presentation.
- Persuasiveness
 - Clarity and tone of voice (Includes voice/Body language/use of props)
 - Factual evidence (Problem – Impact – Solution – Benefit)
 - Sales Pitch (changing consumer thinking, beliefs, objections)
- Marketing
 - Effectiveness of Marketing
 - Call to action.
- Financial Considerations
 - Pricing
 - How much money will you require to start-up your business and where will you go to receive these funds?

Win your first semester tuition to Canadore College. Your account will be credited for the amount owing in first semester tuition. Please note: Winner will still be required to pay any ancillary fees and this prize has no cash value.

First place of the Pitch your Business category has direct entry into the Summer Company program. The winner must meet all program requirements.

Note – Judges will have the opportunity to ask you question following your pitch.
